The sessions will involve a whole range of activities: energetic nature awareness games, tree identification, conservation, fire lighting and camp fire cooking.

School Garden Project

The aim of this ongoing project is to create an educational, enjoyable and edible organic garden in the school grounds that provides a calming environment to be in as well as producing food, flowers and herbs. The children will be involved in every part of the process and will learn about eco systems - insects and plants, waste, growth and cycles of life. This term, Year 4 and Year 3 will be joining Marc on Tuesday mornings.
