Our Health Grant Bid

A big thank to all of you who responded to last month's Health Questionnaire and Health Forum. It was very informative to read your feedback and ideas, which we have included in our Health Grant Bid. There were many common themes amongst the responses. Parents are keen for children to be outside whatever the weather, for example. Additionally, parents talked about the importance of the emotional health and wellbeing of their children. The School Council also responded to questionnaires and their thoughts formed part of our grant application. This has been submitted to the NHS for consideration and we will let you know how it progresses.

Daily Mile

Across the school, children and staff have been taking part in the Daily Mile initiative. Without wasting time changing into full kit, every child in the school, goes out each day in the fresh air to run, jog or walk for up to 15 minutes. It is not competitive and most children average a mile, with some doing more and some doing less. It is not PE, sport or cross-country but a physical activity which is aimed at improving the children's physical, social, emotional, mental health and wellbeing. It can help children to focus and concentrate in the classroom and raise their attainment.
