<u>ENGLISH</u>

We will be starting our English focus by looking at the text 'Tin Forest' by Helen Ward, which links with our new project, 'Home'. We will be working towards writing our own narratives and have some standalone focus lessons on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

GEOGRAPHY

In our project for Term 3 we will be focusing particularly on Geography. We will begin by looking at our local area and then widen our learning to cover Sussex, the United Kingdom and Europe.

We will be exploring human and physical geographical features and how they differ between different areas. We will make sure that we have a good understanding of the different continents and oceans across the globe and we will have an international focus towards the end of term.

SCIENCE

This term, we will be investigating different materials and their properties. We will be using our learning from science to support our project with designing homes!

We will be looking at materials and seeing how suitable they are for different uses. We will begin by looking at grouping materials into solids, liquids and gases.

FRENCH

In French, we will be learning all about ourselves. We will learn the names for the parts of the body, identify colours and say what we are wearing. We will even have a go at singing *Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes*. It is harder that is seems!

<u>MATHS</u>

Our main focus at the beginning of Term 3 will be multiplication and division. We will begin by learning about making equal groups and move on to sharing, and the relationship between them. We will touch on doubles and how we can use arrays to help us answer multiplication questions more easily. Please refer to our calculation policy for support if you need it!
