# **Welcome to Foxes Class Curriculum Information Terms 5 & 6**

### ENGLISH

We will begin our English lessons this term using the text 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs' by A. Wolf (as told to Jon Scieszka!) We will be exploring the text through drama and will be learning about time and place adverbials, conjunctions and onomatopoeia.

### ART

We will be focusing on landscape art over the next two terms, exploring a variety of art techniques and materials. David Hockney and Van Gogh are the artists that we will be especially focusing on. As well as developing our own artistic skills, we will also be learning how to analyse pieces of artwork.

We will be recording our creative journey in our own sketch books as well as creating some final pieces for an art exhibition!

### FRENCH

In French, we will be continuing to learn how to count, say the days of the week and months of the year. We will also be learning the names of common animals and foods.

### SCIENCE

This term we will be making the most of the sunshine and our fabulous outside area to learn all about plants, learning the names of different parts of plants, and the jobs they do. We will be working scientifically and collaboratively to investigate what plants need to grow well.

The children will have the chance to predict what will happen in an exciting investigation into the transportation of water within plants. They will work in a hands-on way to identify the parts of a flower and will explore the different stages of the life cycle of a flowering plant.

### MATHS

Our main focus at the beginning of Term 5 will be fractions. We will then move onto multiplication and division, before returning to further consolidate addition and subtraction.

We will be guided in our planning by the 'Ready-to-Progress' criteria document that has been produced as a result of national school closures to help ensure all children are confident in the key mathematical objectives required for their year group.

### MUSIC

We will be learning to use specific musical terms, for example rhythm, beat, tempo and dynamics. We will be using these terms when analysing pieces of music, learning to listen out for instruments and playing and evaluating musical pieces.

We will be talking about how music can influence our mood as well as discussing likes and dislikes.

### PE

This term PE will continue to be on Tuesdays. Our focus is rounders - we will be honing our batting, bowling and fielding skills, as well as playing the game in teams.



### COMPUTING

In computing we will be researching artists and creating collages.

We will also be learning about electronic statistic programs on Purple Mash and how to enter our data!
