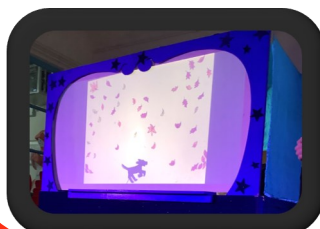
### Gardening -

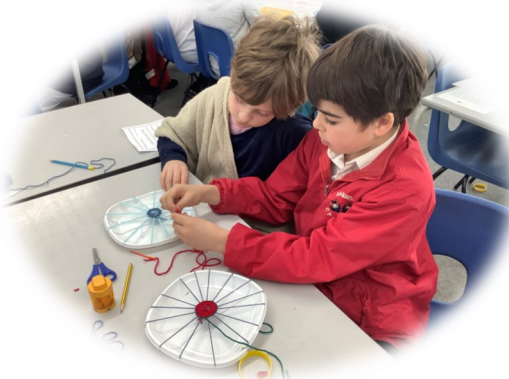
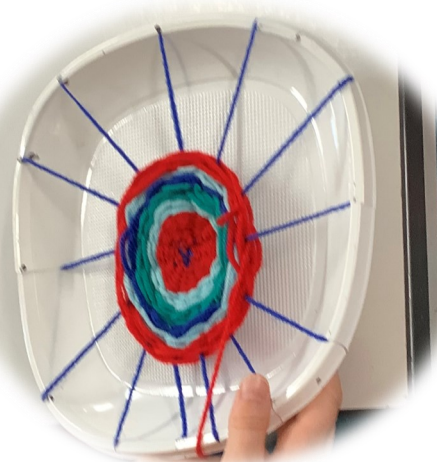
