Coronavirus control measures

Please see below for a brief summary of the control measures we will implement at Hamsey school:

- Pupils will arrive at school and leave school according to the staggered times outlined above
- Pupils will remain in consistent class bubbles throughout the school day;
- Children in Foxes are Hedgehogs classes will be a single bubble to allow delivery of phonics sessions.
- Breakfast and After-School Clubs will be limited to 15 children, and must be booked in advance:
- G-Suite log-ins will be provided in case of localised/national lockdowns in the future;
- Children will be prioritised for testing should they display any symptoms;
- Classrooms will be well-ventilated;
- Children will wash their hands frequently throughout the day, including on arrival at school, before home time and between sessions;
- Cleaning staff will clean the school site at the beginning of the day and in the middle of the day, with a particular focus on high-touch areas such as switches, door handles and tables.
