Animation club is a fun introduction to the art of stop-motion animation. We produce animations using flipbooks, whiteboard animations, clay/Lego and Pivot animator. Children photograph and edit their animations using dedicated laptops, web cams and animation software. By the end children will have completed some short, high-quality animations to take away on a memory stick (which we would ask them to bring from home). Children will be able to keep any flipbooks, clay models/stage props they produce. We hope the films will be screened at a parent/ child screening at the end of the course.
